French and Spanish Speaking Practice The REAL GCSE speaking exams are taking place during the first two weeks of Term 5. This is a final opportunity for pupils to practise their General Conversation Questions in small groups and to get one-to-one feedback and advice from their teachers.

Fine Art & Textiles The art sessions are open to all art students. The final art department exams start in the second week of Term 5 so this will be an additional opportunity for you to use the school facilities to prepare for your exam.

Dance Session open to both BTEC and RSL students for both theory and practical. Choreography exams are in the first 2 weeks when we come back after Easter so pupils need to be ready to perform when we come back. Students will have access to the Dance Studio and chromebooks.

English Tuesday 2nd April open to all Y11 - focus to be confirmed. Just morning session 9.30-11.30am. Wednesday 3rd April - morning session just for classes taught by Miss Flowers and Miss Simons with a focus on Power and Conflict poetry. Afternoon session for all Y11 with a focus on Language Paper 1.

Geography Session is open to all students, especially those who got a Grade 3 or 4 in the January mocks. (CGI to email these students/parents). The session will focus on the application of case studies to exam questions. We will discuss and practise best revision methods and complete some timed written work.

Business The session will be for those students who are resitting one of their PSA units. This will be confirmed next week when results are received for the Component 2 PSA which was submitted in January. Students and parents will be informed by email to confirm.

Science The Tuesday session is for all students taking the foundation level papers, especially those who achieved a grade 3 or 4. The Thursday session is for all pupils taking the higher level papers. The sessions will focus on the papers taken before May half term.

Design and Technology The sessions are open to all students who haven't handed in their portfolio and final product by Thursday 28th March, this will be the last opportunity to finish off or refine your project to achieve the best possible mark. The first session on Tues 4th will be run by Mrs Newton and on Tues 9th by Mr McLeish.

<u>Drama</u> The Wednesday session is for students who need to complete or improve their Unit 1 (scripted performance and coursework) work, this will give you the opportunity to ensure you achieve as many marks as possible before we send the work off to the exam board.

<u>Maths</u> This session is aimed at students who are targeting a Grade 4 or 5 and have not yet achieved this in their mock exams. We will be focussing on exam style questions and looking at how to tackle the big mark problem solving questions.
