Celebration of Progress Weekend - Year 10

Dear Parents and Carers,

At The Whitstable School we want our pupils to be proud of the work they have completed in their exercise books. We recognise that achieving this involves a close partnership between parents, pupils and teachers.

This weekend, pupils should bring home with them their English, maths, science, history or geography and MFL books. We would like to encourage you to spend some time with your child, looking together at the work they have produced in their books.

We expect books to be well presented and work to be complete. Teachers provide feedback in a variety of ways, including verbal and written feedback. This year we have introduced the model below for written feedback and you should see it used across different subjects:

- **Progress** - a comment about aspects of the work or learning which is good;
- **Improve** - ways in which a piece of work or future pieces of work could be improved;
- **Extend** - a task or activity that moves pupils further forward with their learning and/or helps address misconceptions (for example, a question requiring a response).

Pupils should engage with and respond to this feedback in **green pen**, allowing them to refine or improve their work. Written feedback in this format should happen at least twice a term.
