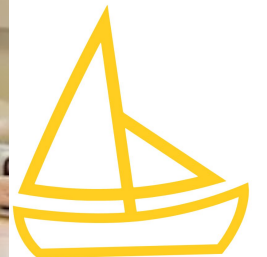

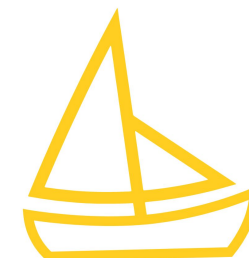

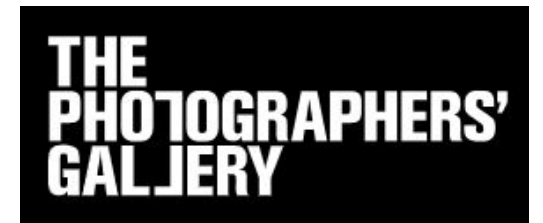

The application timeline

Tonight– Students can talk to different staff about the subjects on offer. Find out their entry requirements.

Students are offered advice and guidance in making choices. Use of PD time for applications.

Kent choices is now open and students start the official application process online.

Students are then invited for an interview in Jan/Feb and a conditional offer is made.

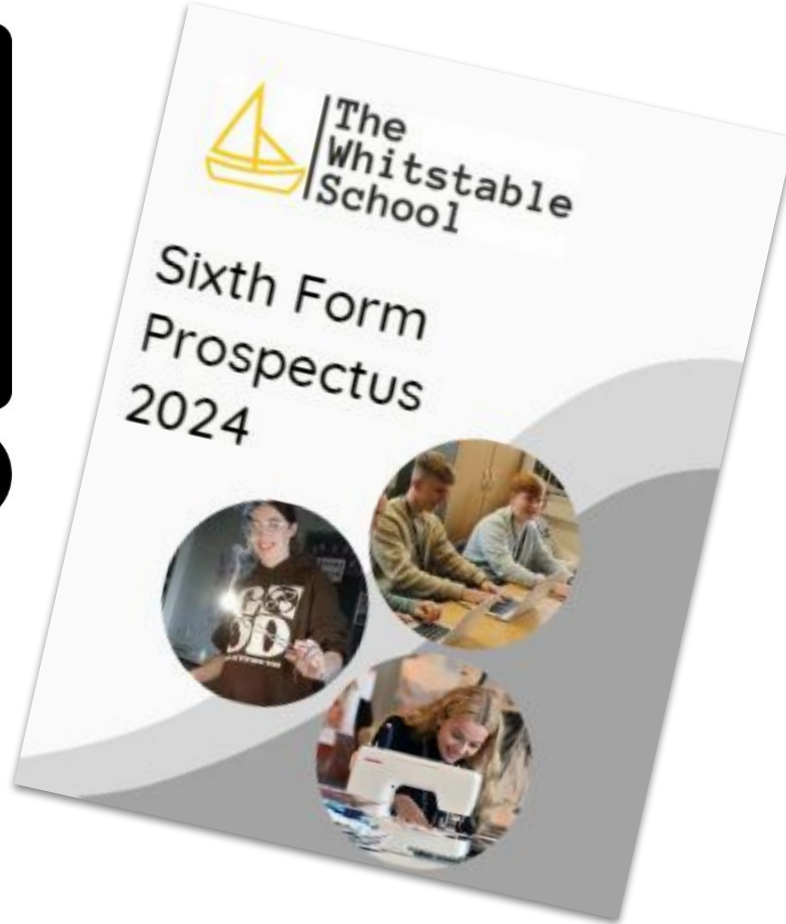
